



Although lacking a first growth château, this region compensates with 11 esteemed classified estates, including renowned second growths such as Léoville-Las Cases, Léoville Poyferré, and Léoville Barton. With almost every acre dedicated to vineyards, Saint-Julien's 900 hectares showcase the commitment of its châteaux to producing exceptional wines. This small-scale appellation attracts both local and international investment, resulting in a captivating blend of tradition and innovation.
